Story

A dowdy antique dealer Norio finds a valuable tea cup of the most famous Japanese tea master Sen no Rikyu from the 16th century when searching inside a storehouse of a rich family. Norio deceives the homeowner Sasuke to get it for almost nothing, but it turns out that Sasuke is a mere house-sitter and the teacup is made by Sasuke himself. When Norio learns that Sasuke used to be a hopeful potter derailed by an antique authenticator Norio himself has a painful history against, the two decide to make the gamble of a lifetime against the authenticator they both have a score to settle with. Involving their wives and children, this act of fraud goes quite unexpectedly.

Sen no Rikyu

Sen no Rikyu, also known as Rikyu, is considered the most famous tea master who had established the Japanese way of the tea ceremony, chanoyu. He emphasized the simplicity of a tea ceremony and also is said to have worked as a fixer in Sengoku period in the 16th century. Though he ended up killing himself ordered by Toyotomi Hideyoshi, who was a general at that time, his way of the tea ceremony still fascinates people today.

Story

A dowdy antique dealer Norio in Kyoto is asked by a beautiful lady Shino to find a swindled historical valuable tea-cup by Master Oribe from 16th century which was passed on by her late father. Norio and a pottery artist Sasuke give her an authentic-looking imitation which Sasuke made for free as replacement. But shortly thereafter, they find out that Shino is a fraud; Shino recognizes their skills and proposes a deal to earn big money in conspiracy by unveiling an underground crime of vice dealers' group selling off lots of fakes internationally. Teaming up with other talented buddies, Norio and Sasuke determine to drive the con-game and to get revenge on the villains who stained on their reputation in the past.

Furuta Oribe's legendary tea bowl

Furuta Oribe (1543-1615) is a warrior who served Oda Nobunaga and Toyotomi Hideyoshi during the Sengoku and early Edo periods and a tea master known as the greatest in Japan after the death of Sen no Rikyu, the founder of the Japanese way of the tea ceremony. He carried on Rikyu's way of tea and established a popular trend in tea bowls, dinnerware, architecture, and gardens that were called “Oribe-gonomi” (Oribe's taste).
